However, if the board/university does not declare equivalent percentage in case of 4-point scale, etc. shall be determined from the following formula: Equivalent Percentage "P=90G/N", where, G is the overall All Grade Point (OGPA) or Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) obtained and N is the maximum of the grading scale.
