

About the University

Sri Karan Narendra Agriculture University, Jobner- Jaipur was established in 2013 by Govt of Rajasthan under Agriculture University, Jobner Act, 2013 (Bill No 39) with a view to impart teaching at the University or college level, conduct research and extension education programmes in the field of agriculture. The territorial jurisdiction and responsibility of this University extend to the districts of Jaipur, Sikar, Alwar, Dausa, Tonk, Ajmer, Bhartpur and Dholpur. The university covers three agro-climatic zones: II A: Transitional plain of inland drainage – Sikar, III A: Semi-arid eastern plain zone- Jaipur, Ajmer, Tonk, Dausa, III B: Flood prone eastern plains- Alwar, Bharatpur, Dholpur .

Rajasthan Agricultural Research Institute (RARI) is one of the premier and oldest agricultural research centers in India, presently functioning as a constituent of Sri Karan Narendra Agriculture University, Jobner, Jaipur. Since its inception in 1943 it has come a long way, overcoming an era of national food deficits to that of self-sufficiency with a surplus food-grains reserve. RARI, Durgapura, Jaipur is serving in the Semi-Arid Eastern Plain Zone-IIIa comprising four districts viz., Jaipur, Ajmer, Dausa and Tonk. The geographical area of the zone is approximately 2.97 million hectare, which represents 8.67% of the total area of Rajasthan.

RARI has been a pioneer in advancing crop improvement, natural resource management, integrated farming systems, and sustainable agricultural development in Rajasthan's semi-arid regions through large network of AICRPs /AINPs/Non Plan and other Adhok research projects. RARI serves as the hub of agricultural research, education, and extension for Rajasthan. The institute's location in Agro-climatic Zone IIIa (Semi-Arid Eastern Plain) makes it ideal for addressing challenges of soil moisture stress, low fertility, and erratic rainfall.

RARI has developed and popularized many high-yielding crop varieties, integrated nutrient management practices, and sustainable farming models suited for small and marginal farmers. Over the years, RARI has received national recognition for its Integrated Farming System models that combine crops, dairy, horticulture and poultry to enhance farmers' income, employment, and resource recycling.

About ICAR- IIFSR, Modipuram

The ICAR-Indian Institute of Farming Systems Research (IIFSR), Modipuram, coordinates the AICRP on Integrated Farming Systems across the country. Established in 1989 as the Project Directorate for Cropping Systems Research (PDCSR) and renamed in 2014, IIFSR is the national nodal institute responsible for developing and promoting sustainable, integrated, and profitable farming systems. The institute's research mandate covers integrated farming, organic and natural farming and cropping systems. It has successfully developed 76 prototype farming system models for 25 States and Union Territories, catering to varied agro-ecological conditions.

Under the umbrella of AICRP-IFS, the institute coordinates 74 centers located in diverse agro-climatic zones, ensuring nationwide collaboration in IFS research, model development with common protocols and methodology. Through these efforts, AICRP-IFS has established scientific framework for system-based research, contributing significantly to national priorities such as achieving the sustainable development goals, improving the income of farmers, soil health, nutritional security and promoting environment friendly farming.

About the City

Jaipur, known as the Pink City of India, is a vibrant blend of royal heritage and modern charm. Founded in 1727 by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II, Jaipur is India's first planned city and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Its historic monuments, architectural marvels, and colorful markets attract visitors from around the world. Jaipur is the capital and the largest city of the Indian state of Rajasthan. It is also known as the Pink City due to the dominant color scheme of its buildings in old city.

The city's major attractions include the Amber Fort, City Palace, Jantar Mantar, Hawa Mahal, Nahargarh Fort, Albert Hall Museum, and Birla Temple. Visitors can also explore the famous Bapu Bazaar, Johari Bazaar, and Tripolia Bazaar for Rajasthani textiles, jewelry, and handicrafts. Recently developed attractions such as the City Park, and Patrika Gate showcase Jaipur's evolving urban landscape. The weather of Jaipur during November is pleasant and cool, with daytime temperatures around 26-28°C and nighttime temperatures dropping to about 12-15°C. The city is well connected by train and bus routes from Delhi, Agra, Ajmer, Ahmadabad, Bangalore and New Delhi. The nearest Airport is Jaipur Airport 02 Km, Jaipur Junction 10 Km, Durgapura Railway station 01 Km and Gandhinagar Railway station 2.5 km and Sindhi Camp Bus Stand is 10 km away from the RARI, Durgapura, Jaipur.

Travel & accommodation

Jaipur, the capital of Rajasthan, is well connected by air, rail, and road to all major Indian cities. The nearest Airport is Jaipur Airport 02 Km, Jaipur Junction 10 Km, Durgapura Railway station 01 Km and Gandhinagar Railway station 2.5 km and Sindhi Camp Bus Stand is 10 km away from the RARI, Durgapura, Jaipur.
